OVERVIEW

In Summer 2021, Canada Nickel began engagement activities with preliminarily identified stakeholders associated with the Crawford Project. The objective of these preconsultation meetings was to share early information regarding Canada Nickel and the Crawford Project, and to identify how Canada Nickel should proceed with its future engagement activities. Engaged stakeholders were identified by proximity to the project and its potentially affected areas, by specific perceived interests, and/or by past or current interest in similar projects or major project development.

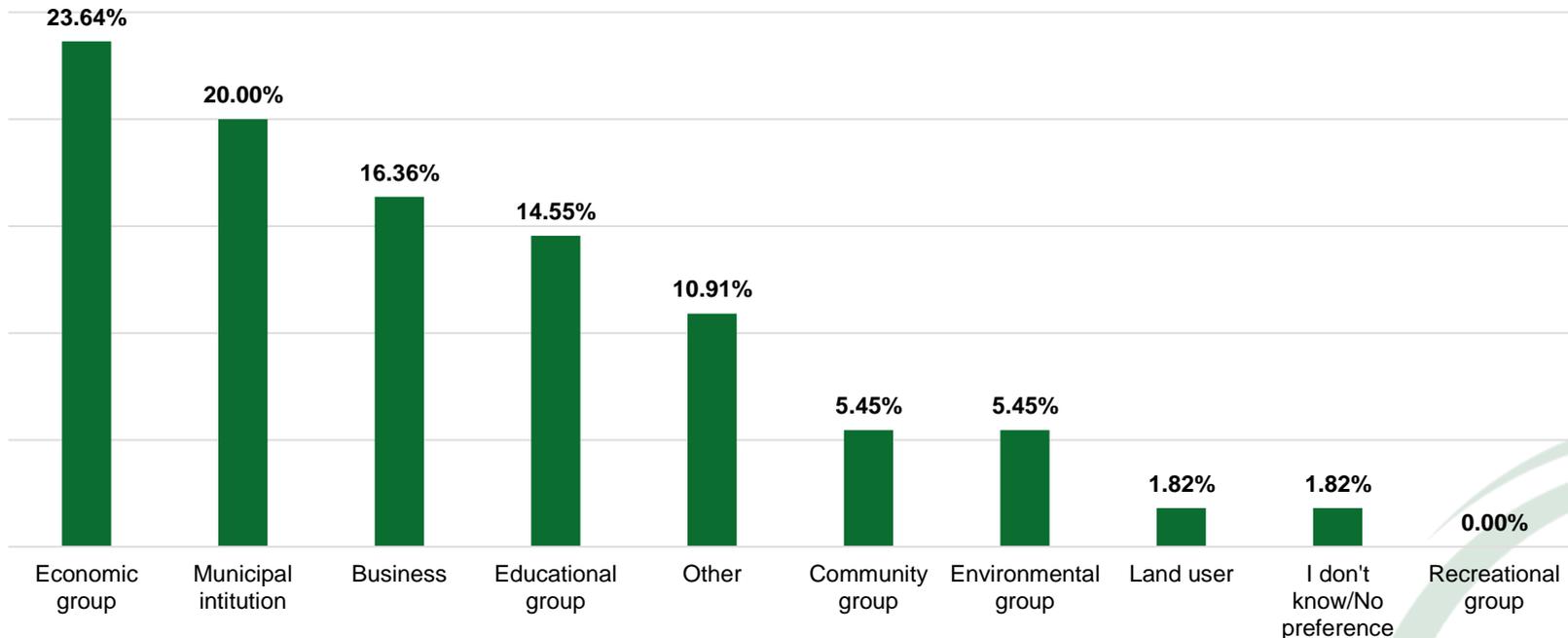
Following the summer 2021 meetings, a feedback survey was distributed to participants. The intent of the survey was to gauge stakeholder preferences for engagement activities and frequency of engagement, primary areas of interest/concern relating to the Crawford Project, and perceived opportunities for Canada Nickel to contribute to regional successes. Given the importance of Indigenous and stakeholder feedback in establishing the project's design and its engagement process, Canada Nickel used the stakeholder feedback shared in the surveys to develop a comprehensive yet tailored stakeholder engagement plan that was then presented for further review and validation.

Of note, Indigenous Communities have a unique engagement process distinct from the aforementioned stakeholder engagement activities.

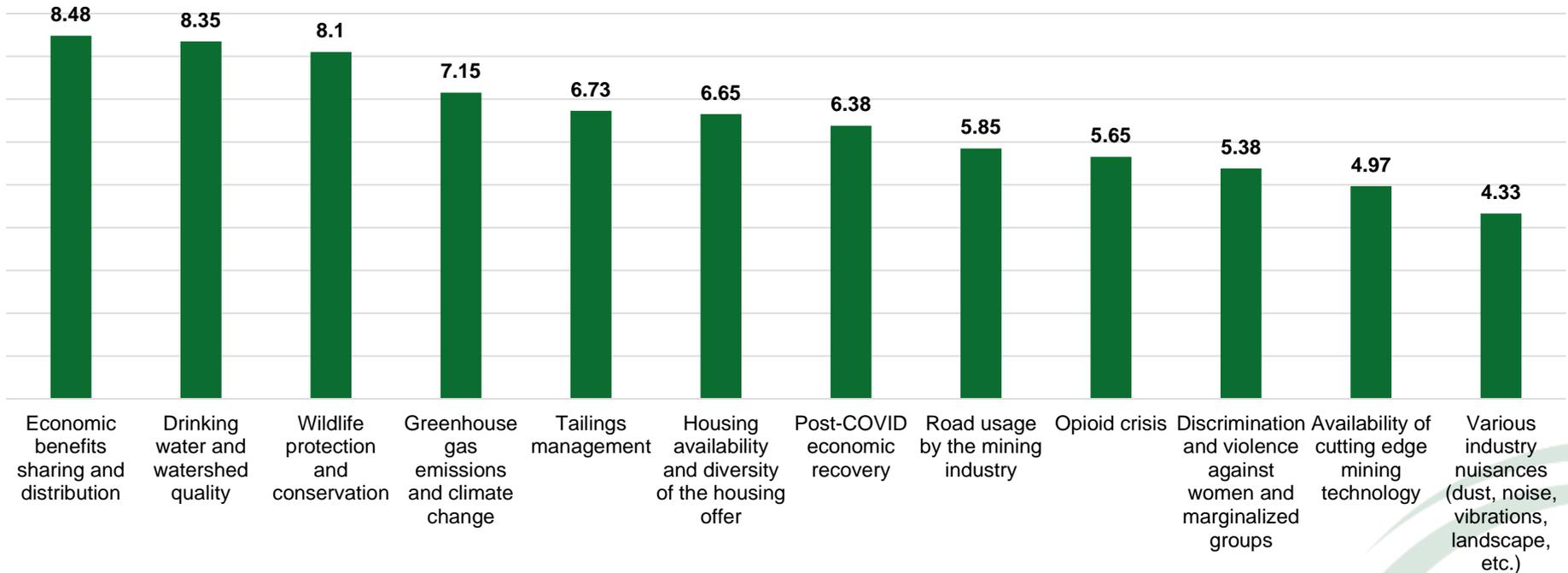

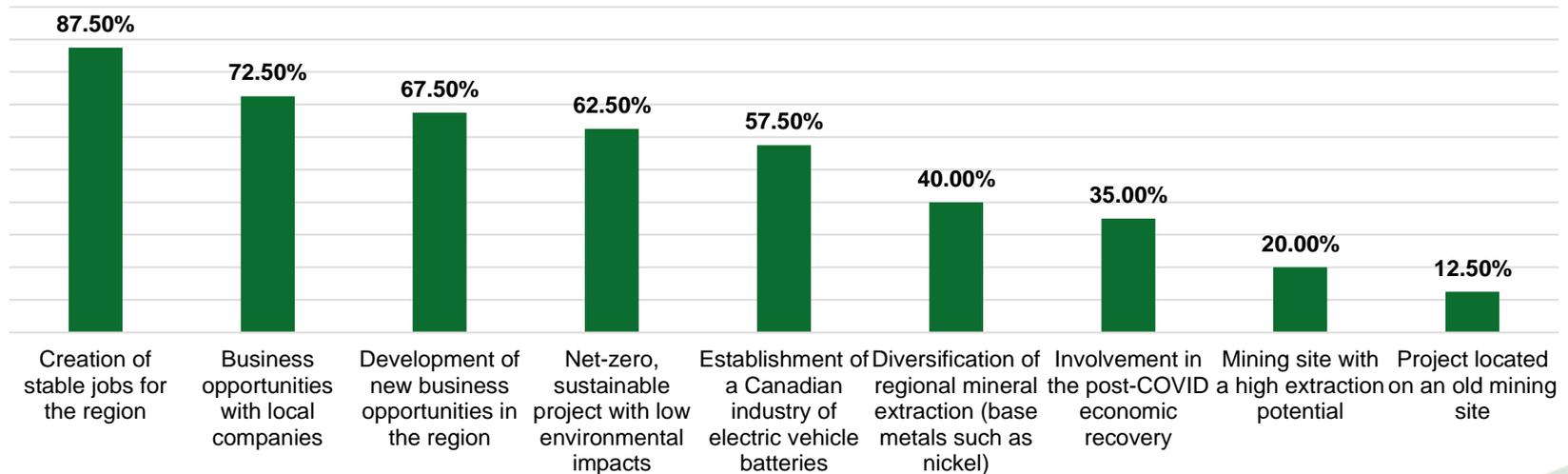
