



Culture, Confidence and Competence (CCC) is an essential skills workforce training program designed by and for Indigenous women and gender diverse people. This 8 week program includes the following:

- · 7 weeks of personal and professional skills building
- · 1 week of industry speaker series to share opportunities and information around careers in different trades and sectors
- · Mental Health First Aid First Nations, First Aid, CPR, and other industry certifications prior to entering the workplace
- Creation of a personalized training plan and access to career coaches/mentors
- Wrap-around supports (e.g. childcare, technology, transportation) and a training allowance
